

2020 – 2021 District 143 REGISTRATION

Starting May 11, 2020

NEW THIS YEAR!!! Registration will be completed **online**. Online registration opens May 11, 2020 and should be completed before July 10, 2020 in order to receive classroom assignments for next year. Registering after July 10th may delay knowing your class assignments. We are confident that by utilizing the **online** registration procedure it will be a smoother process for all.

Due to the COVID-19 Virus outbreak, registration fees **will not be charged for the 2020-2021 school year.**

You do **NOT** have to attend August Registration if:

- All **ONLINE** requirements are completed
- You have a **Kindergarten or 6th grade student** and have his/her **physical and/or immunization forms completed and returned** to his/her school by **July 10, 2020**

You **DO** have to attend August registration if:

- ALL your **online** requirements are not completed
- You have a new student who will be enrolling in the fall (excluding Kindergarten students who registered early)

Computers will be available at each school if you need to complete the online registration

If **online** registration requirements are completed and any necessary medical paperwork is turned into the school office by July 10, 2020, homeroom assignments (pink slip/pink form) should be received via US mail before August registration.

****Each student must have the pink slip/pink form, in hand, to return to school the first day****

Fees

- **NO REGISTRATION FEES WILL BE COLLECTED FOR THE 2020 – 2021 SCHOOL YEAR**
- **Required Gym Uniform for Grades 7 -8:** \$10 for shorts and \$5 per shirt.
- **NEW THIS YEAR for Grades 7 – 8 at Central Park and Kolmar and Grade 6 at Springfield:** A lock will be provided to students. A \$5 replacement fee will be charged if the lock is lost, damaged or not returned in good repair, as issued to him/her.
- **Milk Fee:** If desired, a second milk can be purchased for the school year. The cost will be \$30.00 per student. Contact the school office to add this option to your online registration.


Specific Grade Level Information

- **Pre-Kindergarten Students:** If your child is accepted in the Pre-Kindergarten Program, you will be notified.
- **Kindergarten:** A child must be **five years old on or before September 1, 2020** to be eligible for enrollment in Kindergarten. Medical, vision and dental forms, registration folder, and an official birth certificate **must** be submitted at the August registration, if you did not participate in early Kindergarten registration.
- **Sixth-Grade Students:** **THE LAW REQUIRES STUDENTS TO RECEIVE AN IMMUNIZATION CONTAINING Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV4) along with updated** medical/dental examination forms **must** be submitted. Please send to your school via US Mail/drop off before July 10th to receive your pink slip/pink form by mail or you may return it during the August registration.
- **Kindergarten, Second and Sixth-Grade Students:** By March 23rd of the 2020-21 school year, proof of a dental examination by a licensed dentist is required.

Additional Information

- **Parent-Student Calendar Handbook:** The Calendar/Handbook will be sent home the first week of school. Please read the handbook and keep it in a safe place for reference throughout the year.
- **School Accident Insurance:** The District provides school-time secondary coverage for students, but parents may consider purchasing 24-hour coverage accident insurance at a nominal cost. If you wish to take advantage of this offer, it will be available at the August registration.
- **Proof of Immunization:** Such proof *must be received in order for your child to start school*. This is required by law. This only pertains to those required to have immunizations.

I welcome your return to School District #143 and the opportunity to work with you to promote the growth and future of our children. By working together, we can ensure this will be a successful year for all of our children!
